## Businesses Designate over \$160,000 through EITC Program

In 2001, Pennsylvania became the first state to pass the Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) program, which provides a way for the business community to be directly involved in education. Businesses direct funds that would otherwise go to taxes towards a non-profit scholarship organization. It is a wonderful way for companies to keep their tax dollars in their community. These funds are used exclusively for scholarships for our students with the greatest financial need, approximately 20 percent of our student body.
