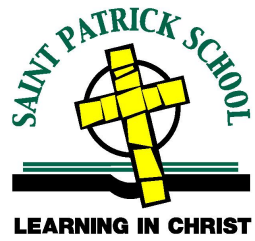


**Saint Patrick School

In 2001, Pennsylvania became the first state to pass the Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) program, which provides a way for businesses and some individuals to be directly involved in education. Businesses direct funds that would otherwise go to taxes towards a non-profit scholarship organization.

These funds are used exclusively for scholarships for our students with the greatest financial need, approximately 20 percent of our student body. Other Ways to Support Our School

- **Saint Katharine Drexel Education Fund:** This fund honors the Philadelphia native who spent much of her life working to provide schools for underprivileged children. Saint Patrick Church was an early benefactor of Katharine Drexel's, receiving money for an education center for children. In honor of the woman who was beatified by Pope John Paul II in 1988, our school has an educational fund for anyone who would like to follow in Saint Katharine Drexel's footsteps. Gifts may be given in honor or memory of individuals and go to students in financial need.
- **Emerald Earnings Program:** Emerald Earnings is a scrip program sponsored by Saint Patrick School. Families purchase gift cards at face value and the school earns a rebate on all gift cards purchased. The school shares the rebates (varying by retailer, from 3% to 20%) with participating families through the EE program. Every purchase benefits the school and you can earn a scholarship just by purchasing gift cards! - **Boxtops for Education:** The school receives thousands of dollars each year through the collection of Boxtops for Education. The program has a new online app this year. Use the app to snap a photo of your receipt **within 14 days of purchase**. You do not need to clip or send Box Tops labels to school. Box Tops earnings are identified and automatically updated at BTFE.com.
